Introduction

The new academic year of Adarsh Charitable Trust started from 2nd June 2014. From its humble beginning in 1998 to wide range of activities in 2014, helping just 7 children to over 450 children a month with the help of 2 rehabilitation centres and different community programmes, really the journey was relentless and is still going on like that.



The main rehabilitation centre at Kureekkad focuses on children affected by Cerebral Palsy, Autism, Down syndrome and the centre at Vyttila helps children with Learning Disorders. Its Community activities are Risk Baby Unit and Home Based Rehabilitation programme.

Training programmes include Developmental training, Physiotherapy, Speech therapy, Occupational therapy, Special education are being etc. Those who can follow academic training, the centre helps them through NIOS schemes. Adarsh is an accredited centre for conducting examinations under OBE (2nd 4th and 7th levels) schemes of NIOS

In June 2014,

At the main Rehabilitation Centre:

- ❖ The centre at Kureekkad reopened on 2nd June 2014 after a month of summer vacation. 22 children took admission in the first month of new academic year.
- ❖ As part of filling up vacancies, 3 special educators were appointed.
- ❖ One new vehicle is introduced on hire to carry more children. A new route is formed. Now centre has 8 vehicles (6 hire and 2 own), carry around 110-120 children a month

- ❖ High5 – a team of staff members from TCS visited Adarsh and donated large number of stationery items. Around 40 people spent a full forenoon with the children and celebrated the time with dances, songs and games.
- ❖ Vayanadinam was observed and conducted reading competitions for children
- ❖ A Vice Principal is appointed for the centre to look after the day to day activities of the centre. (She will be available from 01.08.2014 onwards)
- ❖ Students from Nursing College of Medical Trust Hospital Visited Adarsh as part of their observation on 13.06.2014.
- ❖ Snehasadan School of Special Education with their students visited Adarsh on 20.06.2014

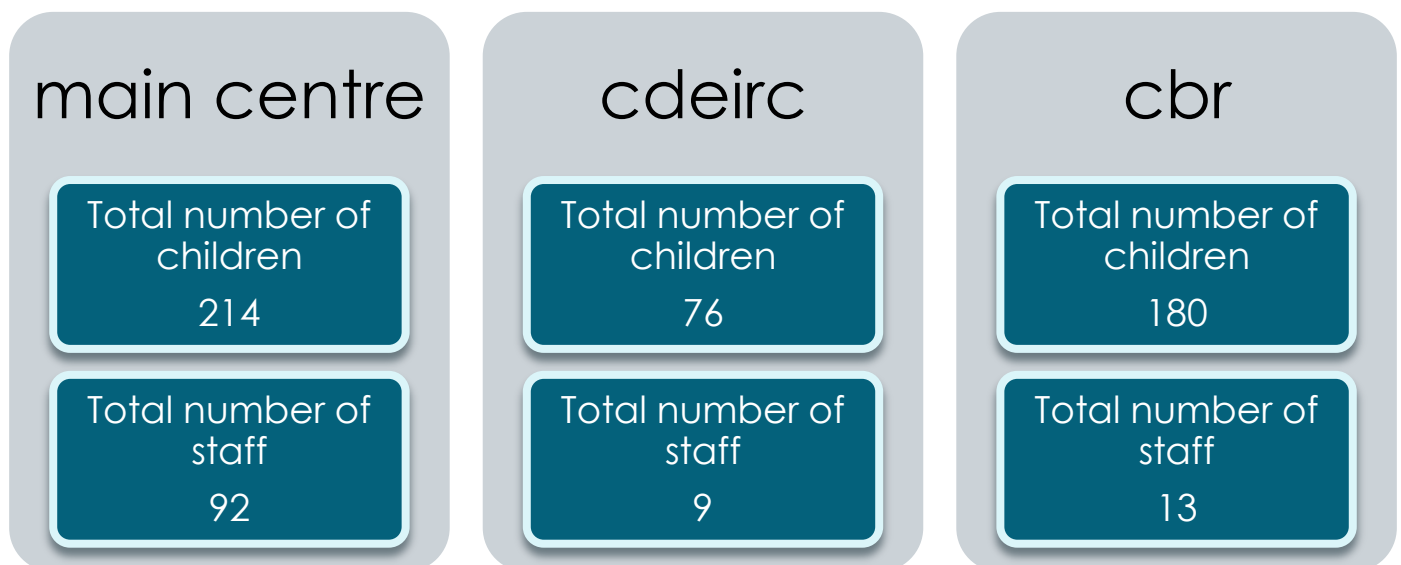
At CDEIRC:

- ❖ The centre was working in May also.
- ❖ A Special educator's vacancy was filled
- ❖ Apart from the remedial education to children with learning disorders, Pediatric evaluation, Psychological evaluation are going on regularly and smoothly

In CBR:

- ❖ Risk Baby Unit - Without any break, the unit is functioning in 4 hospitals in the town. In June the unit examined and guided around 76 babies a month
- ❖ 3 Home Based Rehabilitation units are working in the community and helped ... children from 11 Panahcyats in Ernakulam district
